**City of Petersburg Offices Closed for Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.
Birthday and Lee-Jackson Day**

Petersburg, Va. (Jan. 11, 2017) – City government offices, including City Hall, the City Hall Annex and the Petersburg Freedom Support Center, will be closed on Monday, January 16th in observance of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.'s birthday and will be closed on Friday, January 13th in observance of Lee-Jackson Day. Offices will reopen at normal business hours on Tuesday, January 17, 2017.

- Friday and Monday's closings include Parks and Leisure Services and the Petersburg Public Library. The Petersburg Public Library will be open for regular hours on Saturday, January 14th. Petersburg Animal Care & Control will only be Friday and Monday but will be open on Saturday from 1p.m. to 3p.m.
- Petersburg Area Transit (PAT) buses will also operate on a normal schedule for both the Martin Luther King, Jr. birthday and Lee-Jackson Day holidays. PAT administrative offices will be closed on both holidays.
- Blandford Church will be open Saturday 10a.m-4p.m. and Sunday 1p.m.-4p.m.
- Dogwood Trace Golf Course will operate normal business hours, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Friday and Monday and 7:30 to 5 on Saturday and Sunday.
- Central Virginia Waste Management Authority CVWMA curbside recycling collection and trash collections will continue as regularly scheduled for the holidays.
