Canvass & Provisional Hearing

1. Chairperson Peterson called meeting to order at 3:04 PM.

2. Roll Call

3. Registrar Williams informed the Board that there is no candidate has qualified for the Clerk of Court for the November ballot and that Waylin Ross has filed for the 16th District State Senate seat with 402 signatures; the office is in the process of certifying the necessary 250 signatures to qualify him the November ballot.

4. **PROVISIONAL HEARING:**

The board entered closed session for the provisional hearing at 3:24 PM to consider nine provisional votes from the June 11 primary.

5. The board exited closed session, in which, five provisional votes were accepted, three provisional votes were rejected, and one provisional vote was pending due to ID.

6. **CANVASS**

The board reviewed the recorded numbers with the numbers from the polling machines to certify that they matched.

4,679 votes were cast in the city of Petersburg. Joe Morrissey received 3,356 and Rosalyn Dance received 1,323.

7. Vice Chair Bonner motioned for adjournment, seconded by Secretary Washington. Motion was approved unanimously.
