Proposed Development of Rehabilitation of the Poor Creek Pump Station Force Main:

The City of Petersburg has received and has accepted an unsolicited proposal from Versar, Inc. for a public-private partnership under which the private proposer would provide Rehabilitation of the Poor Creek Pump Station Force Main located at the East edge of East Washington Street (Route 36) to the North edge of the US Route 460.

The City advertised and requested competing proposals during the review of the conceptual and detailed stage submission the City has selected to negotiate a comprehensive agreement with Faulconer Construction Company, Inc.

This unsolicited proposal was submitted pursuant to the Public-Private Education Facilities and Infrastructure Act of 2002, Va. Code §§ 56-575.1, et seq., ("PPEA"), and the City's PPEA implementing procedures.
