

# **Public Information Report**

## ***Public Information Questions from July 16, 2019***

1. What can be done about 321 Grove Avenue?

A plan of action has been set in place for 321 Grove Ave that includes a demand letter sent on August 20, 2019, an advertisement being run during the week of Sept. 2-6, a title being ordered on October 7 and a lawsuit filed in October 2019.

2. Trash trucks are not being cleaned properly after shifts.

A formal complaint is in the works of being filed with CFS.

3. Walls along the Poplar Lawn Park creek are shifting.

City consultants have been contacted pertaining to the walls along the creek and proposals for assessment have been submitted to City Staff. The City will keep the public updated on progress regarding this issue.

4. There have been airline tickets purchased with a City-issued credit card.

These charges were a part of Deputy City Manager, Lionel Lyons' relocation as approved by the City Manager.

5. Will additional signage be placed at Social Services?

Additional signage has been added leading to social services and plans are underway to potentially add additional signs.

6. What is cigarette tax monies used for?

Money collected from cigarette tax is used to support the operation of the general fund.
